

# Special care must be taken with the following substances,



## Gasoline

Total of 25 liters per person.



## Flammable liquid for portable stove

Total of 5 liters per person.



## Gas

Maximum of 11 kg canisters of hydrocarbon gas mixture per person and no more than 24kg in total onboard.

A disposable container of up to 0.7kg with a protected valve per person is allowed.



## Paint/Solvent

Total of 5 liters flammable paint and/or 1 liter solvent/thinning per person.

(The most common flammable paint is oil-based)



## Batteries

Batteries should be protected from short circuit.

Total of one battery rated at 12V/100Wh.

Small batteries e.g. powerbanks may not exceed 100Wh and max 20 batteries per person.

Calculation of Wh for your powerbank:

$$mAh/1000 \times V = Wh$$



## Safety matches/Lighter

Total of 6 boxes or one non-refillable lighter is allowed per person.

*Safety matches/lighter shall be carried on your person.*

*(in a suitable pocket e.g. in your pants)*



## Ammunition

Ammunition type UN 0012 or UN 0014 (division 1.4S) is approved for personal use, max gross weight 5kg per person.



## Machines

Marine engines, chainsaws, generators shall be emptied and sealed to prevent leaks.
